Notes:

- a. With prior approval, college courses may be counted for required courses.
- b. Third Party Sports are done with internship credits like the predecessor school.
- c. We recommend this is done when students are young, and in person, at personal language schools Dominion Prep recognizes. This may also be done with college electives, third party tutors, at your public school or remote schools like Babble, Rosetta Stone or other approved method. Dominion Prep plans to add Chinese, Spanish and Italian languages to the course offering in the next year.
- d. Predecessor School colleges have included Southern Methodist University, John Hopkins, Savanna College of Design (SCAD), and others. Dominion Prep is currently arranging these regular college programs targeting these past colleges, Baylor University and others. This program will start in 2023.
- e. Dominion Prep recommends that students continue to earn college credits or internship projects before being granted a high school diploma before they are physically, socially and legally old enough to run their lives without parental supervision and succeed in college.
- f. Additional Dominion Prep courses and additional college courses in the student's area of interest are recommended. Dominion Prep does not limit college credits earned in high school, and colleges receive very few **high-credit** transcripts and are generally very impressed. There is a NCAA limit on college credits to still count as a freshman athlete.
