


## Outcome Targets of the Dominion Prep Curriculum



**Student achievement** means that students master core and elective content with deep understanding and meaningful conceptual frameworks. Robust student achievement means that students perform well on examinations and authentic performances such as research projects, academic papers, science experiments, mathematical proofs, and oral presentations. **Learner independence** is a critical component of the Dominion Prep curriculum and learning model. The biggest difference between high school performance and college performance is the demand for learner independence. As students traverse the Dominion Prep curriculum they are expected to learn independently in a supportive environment. The demands for independent learning gradually increase as
